HAZARDOUS TREE REMOVAL

Hazardous Tree Removal cutting operations have been completed and all chipping operations will be done by the end of this week. There were a few roads that didn't meet the criteria and a few were access was not available when crews were in the area. In these cases, we will work with our mitigation teams to see what might be possible.



WEATHER UPDATE FROM NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE



Isolated to scattered storms will be weaker today and Tuesday, but still produce a limited flash flood threat due to their slow movement. Wednesday could see stronger storms develop, while Thursday will likely feature more numerous showers and storms but they will be moving faster. However, there will still be a flash flood threat due to potential for training and a few embedded heavier storms.
